The recent changes to MSDS will be reviewed, including the new requirement that any edits that affect your District’s graduation rate be done through MSDS by Count Day 2010, and the non-availability of the GAD review process this winter. Other changes to this falls MSDS collection, which include new data elements not collected on MSDS previously, will also be covered |

The special education data collection system that has been in place for many years, MICIS, has been phased out, and will be replaced with the 3win collection in MSDS starting in November of 2010. The requirements and timelines for this collection will be covered. |

At the end of the 2010-11 school year, districts will be required to submit data on all classes students took during the year, including the Identity of the teacher, and in many cases, the grade the student received in the class. The current state of the collection will be discussed, along with anticipated rollout training options. |
